National Children's Ministry Curriculum Second Quarter: December 2022 – February 2023

Back to God's Reality is the theme chosen for this church year for our children. Let's introduce our children to the **incredible** plan of God for their lives. This plan started many years ago and is, today, still an excellent plan. God created mankind to have a relationship with Him. The children need to understand that this world was not created with flaws. God created this world perfectly. Unfortunately, mankind became disobedient and required God to bring us Back to God's Reality. What is God's Reality?

God's intention is to save all of mankind. He placed a rainbow in the sky to remind us that He will never flood the earth again. Noah was called and he trusted God and followed God's instruction and Noah's family was saved. Are you willing to trust God and allow Him to give you the instruction to live a pure life to take you back to God's reality? Be God's chosen servant today.

Obedient and faithful Moses freed the children of Israel out of Egypt. The Israelites felt trapped as they faced the Red Sea in front of them and Pharaoh's army coming just behind them. Moses knew the God he served and so he listened as God gave the instruction to part the Red Sea. Learn to be obedient and trust God in all situations. God is ever-present and will always be there to help His people, we just need to look to Him by faith and be obedient.


Joshua and his army did not have to do much to cross River Jordan. God instructed them to step into the river and the river parted and was calm and they all crossed on dry land. Joshua was told to be quiet, march around the walls of Jericho seven times and then give a loud shout on the last march. Joshua and the people of God were obedient and the walls of Jericho came tumbling down. If we pray and listen with our heart, God will speak to us and we can conquer any situations or problems without a physical battle or fight. Allow God to fight for you.

Jonah was disobedient and chose to hide from God on a ship. His disobedience made the people on the ship throw him overboard in the deep dangerous sea. Jonah was terrified as he was in the belly of the big fish that he prayed earnestly asking God for forgiveness. God delivered Jonah and

Jonah delivered the message to the people of Nineveh. The people of Nineveh repented and God did not destroy them.

Let us learn to be obedient and faithful people of God. When you **do not** follow God bad things happen; those who did not listen to Noah, drowned; Pharaoh's army drowned in the Red Sea and Jonah was thrown overboard in the sea.

Jonah Runs From God Group Activities

Sermon Title: "Jonah Runs from God"

Scripture Reading: Genesis 37:1-4, 12-28

HIDE AND GO SEEK:

Play this game like the normal Hide and Go Seek game. After the game is over, explain to the children that they cannot hide from God. He always knows where we are and what we are doing.

PIN JONAH IN THE FISH:

Draw a large poster picture drawing of a BIG bright blue fish and a small picture of a little man (Jonah). Children can be blind folded and turned around a couple of times and then try to pin JONAH into the fish! Everyone gets a turn.

STICK FISH:

Give the children 4 craft sticks to form triangles together to create a fish and the tail. Glue the sticks together. Children can paint or color the inside of the fish and write words around their picture from today's story, such as Don't Run from God, don't Hide from God, or "oh oh Jonah, you should have gone to Ninevah!"
